



What to do

SPLASHES OF A CHEMICAL PRODUCT

STRAIGHT AWAY

Projection into the eye

- **Wash immediately** in running water for at least 15 minutes, pulling the eyelids widely apart with the head tilted, affected eye down (get help from a colleague).
- **Contact lenses will get washed out but if not, do not try to take them out.**
- **Do not neutralize.**
- **Do not use eye drops** or any type of ocular solution.
- **See an ophthalmologist as soon as possible.**

Sprayed onto the skin

- **Wash immediately** in running water for at least 15 minutes without rubbing.
- **Do not neutralize or use any product (detergent, cream, etc.).**

FOLLOWING DAYS

- **Go to** a doctor's surgery, the Emergency Department or the workplace's medical unit within 24h.
- **Fill out an "Accident in the Workplace" form.**
- **Notify the Prevention Assistant** and **report** the incident or accident in the Health & Safety Log.
- **Report the incident or accident** to the Prevention Adviser.
- **Go to see the Prevention Physician** and report any symptom that you notice in the days following the incident or accident.

PREVENTION

- **Handle** chemical products in a **fume cupboard**.
- **Wear safety goggles** with side bars, suitable gloves and a buttoned up coat.
